Siewert Plains an 8-bed living facility made available to Prairie Harvest Mental Health through a Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG). Siewert Plains opened in May of 2008 in an effort to bridge the gap between transitional and permanent living for adults with serious mental illness.

Siewert Plains consists of 3 floors. All eight individual bedrooms are located on the second floor. Stairs are the only way to navigate the 3 floors. Shared living, kitchen and dining rooms are located on the first floor. A conference room and two offices complete the first floor. A finished basement includes laundry facilities, leisure area and exercise equipment providing ample room for eight individuals. A van is available for transportation.



Supportive services include Northeast Human Service Center Case Management and Prairie Harvest Mental Health supportive services. Staff focuses on skills building and groups are required. Siewert Plains is suited for individuals developing activities of daily living, coping and independent living skills. All residents are required to learn and complete chores with assistance and/or direction is provided for those who may struggle. Teaching skills is valuable as many residents have not lived independently at this point in their lives.
